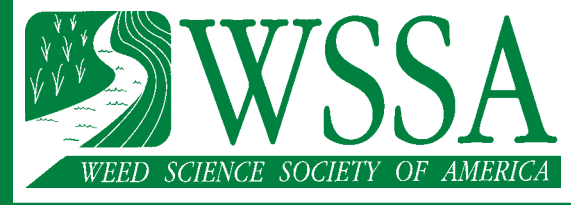

This allows you easy access to thousands of pages of information not contained in the program.
